1. The Christian religion inspired rebellion

Hong was not pleased w/ Manchu rule.

↳ He hoped it would spark change.

2. Hong had been denied of a gov't job (b/c he failed the exams)

3. Many peasants had been suffering

from famine. Overall dissatisfaction.

4. The dynasty began to weaken during the late 1800's

↳ parts of China lost control to local warlords.

Boxer Rebellion.

1. Economic development had been declining in China due to foreign influence and control of economies.
 2. - overthrow Qing dynasty ^{Manchus}
 - rid China of all ^{Manchus + European} foreign influence; leading China into a new era of prosperity.

 - A Multinational force brought an end to the Boxer Rebellion.
 - The Qing dynasty was weakened.
 - But the foreigners still remained.
- * Collapse of imperial China into the 20th.
